Gale Wolf, Update: Heather Platt, a former DC Water Intern is now working with the DPL monitoring activity for the grant that extends through October. Activity includes monitoring water quality and iron and habitat research. A meeting is upcoming with DNR and they are developing a new way to monitor iron flock.

Water Ecology and Safety/AIS

TAISP: started monitoring CLP, (desperately in need of volunteers.). CLP starting to form turions early. CLP has been found in Fawn lake and divers will be out to pull weed Purple Loosestrife beetles are out early.

Rest and Clear boat landings are being monitored. AIS training and a Float Your Boat rally are upcoming events.

Discovery Center has completed two lakeshore restoration gardens, with help from 60 kindergartners.

Fish Habitat Project: Fish Stick Grant (Healthy Lakes Initiative) Rest, Clear and Spider Lakes will receive fish stick drops this year.

Town Board meeting 6/12/18:

A new patrol boat and radio is being manned 50 hours per week. A plan for Rest Lake erosion plan is being developed.

Koller park docks to be replaced, 5 docks with build boardwalks with walking ramps. It is hoped the town employees and volunteers build will build the boardwalk, town will contract with a dock provider for docks, composite decking. Fire Wise program, to speak at our annual meeting.

A suggestion was made to ask the town board to post signage at boat landings relative to courteous and legal boating.
